Kenya National Seminar on Census Data Analysis, Nairobi, Kenya, 19-22 March 2012

The United Nations Statistics Division has organized the Kenya National Seminar on Census Data Analysis. The main objective of the national seminar was to provide an opportunity for the staff member of the Kenya National Bureau of Statistics (KNBS) and other relevant organizations in Kenya to further analyze data from the 2009 population and housing census of Kenya on selected topics. The ultimate objective is to promote greater analysis and dissemination of the data collected from the Kenya 2009 census. The national seminar was attended by 21 participants representing KNBS, the Population Studies and Research Institute of University of Nairobi (PSRI), the National Coordinating Agency for Population and Development (NCPD), the Civil Registration Department, and UNSD. The national seminar covered the following topics: (i) population projections at sub-national and sectoral level, (ii) analysis of data on international migration, and (iii) analysis of data on gender issues. After the seminar, participants are expected to produce thematic analytical reports, based on analyses generated during the seminar.
